

Notice of Pending Application/Public Hearing for Pier

Chris Hummel, N1958 CTY RD O, Delavan, WI, 53115, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to place a new pier on Geneva Lake. The pier will be constructed with 8 rock filled wood cribs and all materials will be brought in by barge and any materials such as old cribs will be removed up land. The main pier is 6' wide and 100' long with a 9' wide and 20' long load platform incorporated into the end of the pier. The pier has a 3' wide 30' long slip fingers connected with 6' wide 15' long crosswalks. The total pier width is 24' added to 25' of riparian zones or a total of 49' in an extend lot line method that spans 50' at the shoreline and at 100' out 50' wide. The project is located in NW 1/4, SW 1/4, Section 09, Township 01N, Range 17E in Town of LINN, Walworth County.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.12(3m), and 30.208, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit or contract for the proposed activity.


The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
