

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Piers, docks and wharves

Deb Boormanian, Summer Retreat N1929 Bluff Ln., Lake Geneva, WI 53147 has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to replace an existing pier. The project is located in NE 1/4, SW 1/4, Section 09 Township 01N, Range 17E located in Town of Linn, Walworth County.

The proposed project will be a completely new construction, one boat slip pier with mooring platform. The purpose of this project is to replace the existing pier. The existing pier has not been installed for a few years due to the condition of it. The new owners would like to dispose of the old pier and bring the property up to date with a new safe and usable pier for their needs. All the new material for the job will be built out of Douglas Fir at our shop. 6-12-inch granite boulders to sink cribs and keep them in the correct locations. Once we start the project, trucks, trailers and barges will be used to haul out old pier and materials. Once we get the old pier out of the way we will haul in the new material to the job site.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.12 Wis. Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed activity.

If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed, verbalized, or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed, verbalized, or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.


If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
