The project proposes to build a new slip with a canopy frame over a boatlift in the slip. In the Geneva tradition the pier will be constructed with pine fir and stained white. The canopy frame will be constructed out of aluminum and covered with a canvas. There will be cribs placed on the lake bed made of pine fir and filled with clean field stone.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.20, and 30.208, Stats., and ch. NR 150, Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed activity.

If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
