Barry Machado, N1738 Wildwood Drive, Geneva, WI, 53147, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to dredge Trinke Lagoon on Lake Geneva. The project is located in the North East ¼ of the South East ¼ of Section 10, Township 1 North, Range 17 East in the town of Linn, Walworth County, Wisconsin.

The proposed 2022 dredging project is to remove an average thickness of two feet of material from the bed of the lagoon to remove the Starry Stonewort (a macro-algae). This proposed dredging project will remove an estimated total of 5,400 cubic yards.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.20, and 30.208, Stats., and ch. NR102, NR103, NR-150, NR299, NR345, NR347 Wis. Adm. Codes.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will issue the permit for the proposed activity.

A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.

If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
