

Notice of Pending Application for Proposed Riprap

Theodore Collins, N1822 Birch Drive, Lake Geneva, WI 53147, on behalf of Edgewater Terrace, has applied to the Department of Natural Resources for a permit to replace approximately 100 lineal feet of concrete sea-wall along the shoreline of Geneva Lake. The project is located in NW 1/4, SW 1/4, Section 09 Township 01N, Range 17E located in Town of Linn, Walworth County, and is directly to the east of W4096 Lakeview Dr.

The Department will review the proposal provided by the applicant and any information from public comments and the public informational hearing. The Department will determine whether the proposal complies with ss. 1.11, 30.12 and 30.208, Stats., and chs. NR 102, 103, 150, 299, and 328 Wis. Adm. Code, and ensure that the required mitigation meets the standards in s. 281.36(3r), Stats. if the project impacts wetlands.

The Department has made a tentative determination that it will *issue* the permit for the proposed activity.

If you are submitting general comments on the proposal, they must be emailed, verbalized, or postmarked within 30 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. If you are requesting a public informational hearing, the request must be emailed, verbalized, or postmarked within 20 days after the date this notice is published on the Department's website. A request for hearing must include the docket number or applicant name and specify the issues that the party desires to be addressed at the informational hearing.


If no hearing is requested, the Department may issue its decision without a hearing. If a public informational hearing is held, comments must be postmarked no later than 10 days following the date on which the hearing is completed.

The final decision may be appealed as indicated in the decision document.
